REQUISITE DOCUMENTS FOR MEDICAL TREATMENTS VISA

1. Application form duly filled in block capitals. Application must be signed and dated in front of the staff at the "Italy Visa Application Centre". The visa application form can be downloaded for this web site.
2. One recent colour passportsize photograph (white background preferably)
3. Passport valid for at least 9 months from the date of departure for Italy plus clear photocopy of passport's ID page and of ALL Visas previously obtained (if any) and passport must have at least a both side blank page.
4. Declaration issued by the Italian public hospital indicating the type of treatment, the expected date of beginning of the treatment, its supposed duration and the estimated cost. It has to be noted that medical treatments in private hospitals are authorized only if the private hospital has established a specific convention with the National Health System.
6. Declaration issued by the Italian public hospital certifying that a sum corresponding to the 30% of the estimated cost of the treatment has been paid in advance
7. Proof of availability of financial means adequate to cover the balance of the costs of the medical treatment plus the board and lodging besides the hospital and the air return ticket for the patient and the person accompanying him/her. If these expenses are to be borne by a third person (Italian or alien residing in Italy), a formal letter of undertaking has to be submitted, with photocopy of the guarantor's identity card and copy of his/her bank statement.
