1. Application form duly filled in block capitals. Application must be signed and dated in front of the staff at the "Italy Visa Application Centre". You can download the visa application form from this web site		
2. One recent colour passport-size photograph (white background preferably)		
3. Passport valid for at least 18 months from the date of visa application plus clear photocopy of passport's ID page		
4. Original and photocopy of " DICHIARAZIONE PER FAMILIARE AL SEGUITO " duly filled and signed by the Italian citizen. The form of this " DICHIARAZIONE PER FAMILIARE AL SEGUITO " can be downloaded from this web site. This declaration must be accompanied by a clear photocopy of either the identity card of the Italian citizen or his/her passport (the first four pages)		
6. Photocopy of "Stato di famiglia" issued by the Italian Municipality, relevant to the person who has applied for the "familiare al seguito"		
7. Marriage certificate duly registered by the Legalization Section of the Consulate General of Italy (in case of visa for the spouse of an Italian citizen)		
8. a) Birth Certificate - duly legalized by the Legalization Section of the Consulate General of Italy - if born after 14 th December 1992. or b) Attestation of age issued by National Population Commission - duly legalized by Legalization Section of the Consulate General of Italy - if born before 14 th December 1992. This attestation must be accompanied by an affidavit of age sworn to by either of his/her parents or if the are deceased by an uncle, aunt or older sibling		
9. Consent to leave Nigeria given by the parent living in Nigeria in the form of a Sworn Affidavit with passport photo plus photocopy of own passport (if applicable)		
10. National Population Commission Attestation of Age duly legalized by the Legalization Section of the Consulate General of Italy (in case of visa for the parent of an Italian citizen)		
11. Affidavit sworn by the parent living in Nigeria or the tutor, indicating the name and passport number of the person traveling with the minor to Italy (copy of this person's passport attached to the sworn affidavit). If the minor is travelling unaccompanied, the name of the airline should be mentioned.
